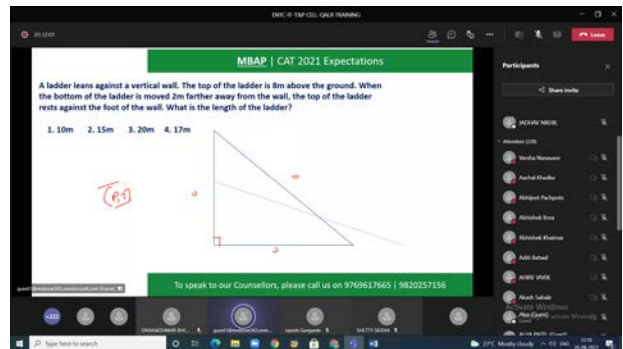

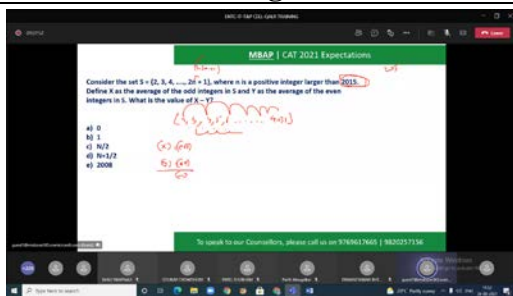

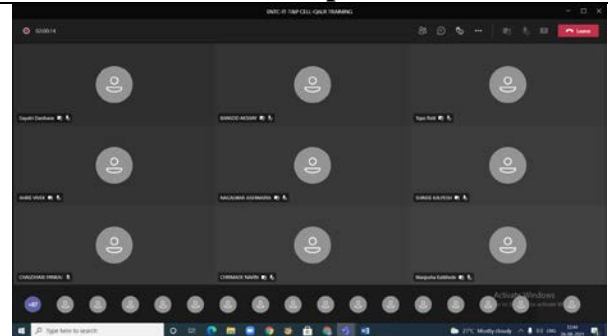
Introduction of CAT exam by Mr. Abhijeet Singh

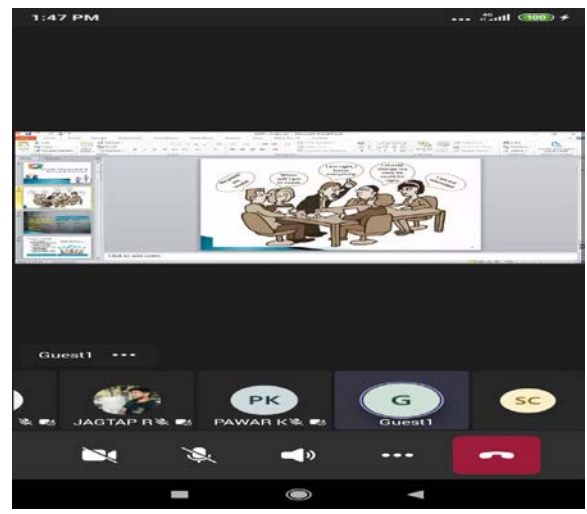
