1. Regular Activities

- 7 Days Residential Camps in adopted village.

- b. Production Oriented Program
- c. Relief and Rehabilitation
- d. Education and Receptions

Eligibility for getting benefits

- A student enrolled in NSS should work for continuous two years and is expected to put in **at least 120 hours** of social service (in at least two community-based projects) in both the academic years.
- The enrolled NSS volunteer also expected to participate at least one **07 days** special camp during his enrollment in NSS of two years.

Incentives

- **A certificate from SPPU University** after completing 240 hours in 2 years (i.e., 120 hours each year) and one Special camp of 07 days according to rules and regulation of the University.
