Introduction

The college has a proactive committee dedicated to preventing incidents of ragging. The committee consistently reinforces awareness among students about the repercussions of ragging and ensures that both parents and new students are informed about their rights. This Anti-Ragging Committee is established in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Supreme Court of India and UGC, aiming to prevent ragging and implement anti-ragging measures within the college.

The students can convey their ragging problems to members of committee. The following instructions are framed to prevent the menace of ragging and foster healthy interpersonal relations among students in the campus of RMD Sinhgad School of Engineering. Ragging is strictly prohibited in or outside the college campus.

In a broader sense, ragging encompasses any action that leads to mental, physical, or sexual abuse, verbal mistreatment, indecent behavior, criminal intimidation, wrongful restraint, undermining human dignity, financial exploitation, or the use of force.

All students shall familiarize themselves with rules/regulations/guidelines on code of conduct, anti-ragging measures and discipline College. All 'new comers' should attend counseling sessions organized for them from time to time by the college staff.

It ensures the implementation of the preventive measure and undertakes frequent and surprise checks/ visits to ensure ragging free campus

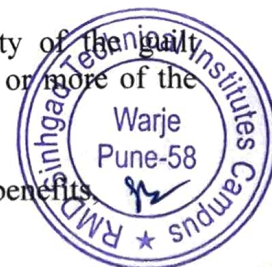
Objectives

1. To maintain a vigilant presence and deter the occurrences of Ragging, if any, within areas of student congregation, including classrooms and the canteen.
2. To educate students on the dehumanizing impact of ragging inherent in its perversity.
3. To sustain an ongoing watch and vigilance against ragging to prevent both its initial and repeated instances.
4. To supervise, guide, and oversee the activities and effectiveness of the Anti-Ragging Squads in the prevention and control of ragging within the institution.
5. To promptly and rigorously address reported incidents of ragging.
6. To enlighten students through various means about the menace of ragging and the associated consequences.

Functions of Committee

The institution will take disciplinary action against a student proven to be involved in ragging, following the prescribed procedure outlined below.

- a) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- b) The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the incident established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
 - i. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges,
 - ii. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.

- iii. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
 - iv. Withholding results,
 - v. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc
 - vi. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel,
 - vii. Cancellation of admission,
 - viii. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- c) To consider the complaints received from the students and conduct enquiry and submit report to the Anti-Ragging Committee along with punishment recommended for the offenders;
- d) Oversee the procedure of obtaining undertaking from the students in accordance with the provisions;

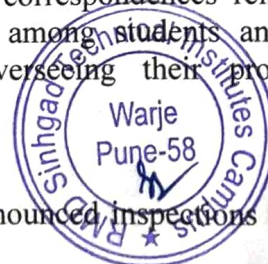

Responsibilities:

Establish a system for receiving, processing, and addressing all information concerning incidents of ragging. Formulate and disseminate a credible anti-ragging policy within the college. Advise the Disciplinary Committee and its sub-committees on the implementation of new policies or directives for handling ragging cases, as applicable, periodically. Address grievances of stakeholders promptly, especially those related to gender sensitivity issues, including instances of sexual harassment of women. Conduct sensitization programs for employees regarding cases of ragging. Maintain comprehensive records, statements, actions, and other correspondences related to ragging cases. Discuss significant ragging cases to raise awareness among students and faculty. Ensure the establishment of various cells and committees, overseeing their proper functioning, and implementing a monitoring mechanism.

Functions and Duties of Anti Ragging Squad:

1. This Committee shall be fully responsible to ensure that no incidence of ragging as defined in Rule 2 of these regulations takes place and will also monitor and ensure that the instructions of these regulations are followed fully at all points of time.
2. The Committee will also maintain alert vigil at all times and ensure that the Anti-Ragging Squads/Anti- Ragging Helpline of the University carry out their functions properly and efficiently.
3. The Anti-Ragging Committee will be responsible and function under the overall direction of the Director
4. The members of the squad will visit at least once in a week all potential areas of ragging in or outside of the college and hostel premises, including at night and may apprehend the culprits.
5. The members must be vigilant at all hours including at odd hours all round the campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
6. The members must conduct anonymous random surveys among fresher's to ensure that the campus is free from ragging:
7. The members must conduct on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the Institution or any member of the faculty, staff, student, parent or guardian or employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with the recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti Ragging Committee for action.
8. The members must ensure the display of posters on the institute notice boards and other prominent places.

1. The reconstruction of the AntiRagging Committee was approved in compliance with UGC rules and modifications. In order for student members to tell their fellow students about the actions the college is taking to put a stop to the ragging epidemic, it was agreed to include student representatives on the Committee. To discuss the agenda, the first meeting of the anti-ragging committee for the academic year 2023–24 was convened on **23rd Nov 2023**, at **12:00 pm** in the principal's office. The meeting's discussion was continued on the agenda items with the attendance of the committee members.

1. To investigate the tactics used to educate students about the institution's "Zero Tolerance" policy against ragging. The committee gave its approval to the meeting's minutes.
2. It was decided that student representatives would be included on the Committee so that student members could inform their fellow students of the steps the college is taking to end the ragging epidemic.
3. It should describe the precise steps taken inside the institution to raise awareness of the negative effects of ragging and the necessity to prevent any future incidents. It was determined that the members of the anti-ragging committee would serve as squad members for overall surveillance and supervision in the college's classes in order to prevent ragging on the college campus. Any student who is caught engaging in such behaviour may be brought immediately to the authority's attention.
4. In regards to any complaints, there haven't actually been any occurrences of this kind documented; the campus is a ragging-free zone.
5. The committee agreed that immediate action should be made to further strengthen ragging prevention and prohibition in the college.
